II. COURSE AIMS

The Internship 2 aims to offer students the opportunity to obtain a range of practical experience and to network within an intended career field. Interaction with professionals with varied backgrounds and experiences should help students develop skills essential to the profession. This internship also serves as a chance for students to nominate themselves to recruiters as potential candidates.

III. COURSE DESCRIPTION

Internships can be with a variety of host organizations, including foreign companies, schools and universities, foreign language centers, travel companies, translating offices etc. Students will work with professors and/or Internship directors in their discipline to establish plans and learning objectives specific to their internships (e.g. have more classroom observations, prepare classwork documents, and proceed with demonstration teaching). A minimum of 40 working days is required (24 days of site visiting, 10 days to write the final report, and 6 days to get approval from the Dean and/or Advisors). Specific deliverables include the Registration form, Visual evidence (photos, videos), evaluation forms completed and signed with

comments by the site advisor(s) and the final report completed by the intern, evaluated and signed by the faculty advisor.
